The television broadcast stations WGBO-DT and WXFT-DT historically have comprised a separate employment unit from the commonly owned radio broadcast stations, WOJO-FM – WPPN-FM – WRTO(AM) and WVIV/WVIX-FM. However, effective as of September 1, 2014, as part of a corporate reorganization that resulted in the stations sharing one or more employees, the WGBO-DT and WXFT-DT employment unit was consolidated with the WOJO-FM – WPPN-FM – WRTO(AM) and WVIV/WVIX-FM employment unit.

The information contained in this Report covers the time period beginning **August 1, 2014 – July 31, 2015** (the "Applicable Period").

The FCC's 2002 EEO Rule requires that this Report contain the following information:
